Direct service to students is provided by AmeriCorps members who are future teachers, guidance counselors, and community leaders.

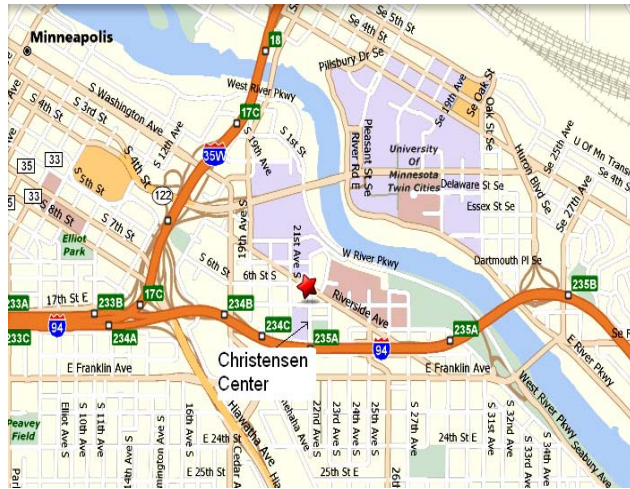

Augsburg is located at 2211 Riverside Avenue

Christensen Center is on 22nd Avenue South

**35W from the North:** Take Washington Ave. exit and turn left on Washington (becomes Cedar Ave.); turn left at Riverside, right at 22nd Ave. South.

**35W from the South:** Follow I-94 St. Paul sign (move to right lane after each of two mergers). Take 25th Ave. exit; turn left on 25th Ave.; turn left at Riverside; turn left at 22nd Ave. South.

**I-94 from Minneapolis:** Take 25th Avenue exit, turn left at 25th Avenue, turn left at Riverside Avenue, turn left at 22nd Avenue South.

**I-94 West from St. Paul:** Take Riverside exit; turn right at Riverside; turn left at 22nd Ave. South.
